



FOUNDER & DIRECTOR BIOS

Aaron Norris, Co-Founder

Aaron Norris has been an influential force in action films and television for more than 30 years. He made his mark as a stuntman and stunt coordinator before moving into writing and producing films, including Silent Rage, Lone Wolf McQuade and Invasion U.S.A. Aside from directing several features (Braddock: Missing In Action III, Delta Force II, Sidekicks, Top Dog, Platoon Leader), Norris is well known for the incredible success of his hit CBS series Walker, Texas Ranger, for which he served as showrunner and executive producer, as well as directing numerous episodes. He is currently in pre-production on the action film The Novice.

Bill Banowsky, Co-Founder

Bill Banowsky began his career in the film industry in 2001 when he founded Magnolia Pictures, a film distribution company based in Austin, Texas and New York City. In addition to serving as CEO of Magnolia, from 2004 through 2007 he served as CEO of Landmark Theatres. the nation's largest chain devoted to art and independent film. Banowsky currently owns and operates Violet Crown Cinema, a boutique cinema in downtown Austin, and Carolina Cinemas, a North Carolina chain with theaters in Asheville; Charlotte and Raleigh, including The Carolina Asheville, host venue for ActionFest Film Festival, Prior to entering the film industry, Banowsky practiced law and served as Executive Vice-President and General Counsel of Capstar Broadcasting, Chancellor Media, and AMFM, Inc. He now serves on the board of LIN Media, a multimedia company that owns or operates 32 networkaffiliated broadcast television stations

Dennis Berman, Co-Founder

Dennis Berman is a leader in the area of effective new teaching methods, having founded Trivac and invented LIT, a patented learning program. He has founded several successful companies including Mirex Corporation, Denitech Corporation, and was a major shareholder and advisor of Voyager Expanded Learning. He has been involved with many not-for-profit boards related to

learning, such as Just for the Kids and Winston School and is currently on the boards of KERA, PBS telecast, Dallas . County Community College District and The Center for BrainHealth, a part of The University of Texas at Dallas. In 2007, UT's The Berman Laboratory for Learning and Memory was established, and he has been involved in education on the Governor's Business Council.

Tom Quinn, Co-Founder

Tom Quinn is the Co-President of Radius-TWC; a new distribution label at The Weinstein Company whose acquisitions include Bachlorette, Only God Forgives. Expatriate and Pusher. Previously, Quinn spent more than seven years at Magnolia Pictures as SVP and Head of Acquisitions, and created Magnet Releasing, Magnolia's genre arm, the Six Shooter Series, as well as the annual Oscar Shorts Program. He also helped launch Drafthouse Films by partnering on their first release Four Lions. Over his career he's acquired and distributed more than 100 films, including Ong Bak, Man On A Wire, The Host, Let The Right One In, Melancholia, 13 Assassins, Hobo With A Shotgun, Trollhunter, Centurion and Monsters. His productions include Outrage, Cocaine Cowboys 2, Splinter and ABC's Of Death. Quinn is also a programmer. having worked for Philadelphia, Atlanta and Woodstock.

Colin Geddes, Festival Director

Colin Geddes has been an international programmer at the Toronto International Film Festival since 1997 and is highly regarded for his work in the festival's Midnight Madness selection, introducing new talent and hosting the premieres of films including Takashi Miike's *Ichi The Killer*, Eli Roth's *Cabin Fever*, *Ong Bak* and *The Raid: Redemption*. He is on the advisory committee of the Toronto Reel Asian Film Festival, Austin Fantastic Fest, and has served on the juries of several international film festivals. Over the past fifteen years, Geddes has rescued abandoned 35mm prints from Toronto's closed Chinatown cinemas and garbage heaps and in March 2010 he donated 200 feature films originating from Hong Kong and Taiwan to the University of Toronto.



long-suffering wife and two teenage children groan every time he comes home with a movie.





Meet Solomon Kane: dressed in black and armed with a rapier and flintlock pistols, blasting and slashing on a mission of pillage and plunder in war-torn North Africa in the 1600s, a true rogue whose hopelessly corrupt soul attracts the attention of the Devil himself. James Purefoy (*Ironclad*, *Rome*) as Kane has looked into the fiery pits of hell, and is ready to redeem himself by fighting evil with his blade.

Kane comes to us from the mind of Robert E. Howard, legendary creator of *Conan the Barbarian*. Director Michael J: Bassett brings this swashbuckling hero to life with more depth and intrigue than Arnie was able to deliver, in a gritty manner that makes the mud, filth and blood feel all too real. But our hell-bent hero never takes his valiant quest too seriously; *Solomon Kane* marks a glorious return to high-spirited action and adventure. — *Colin Geddes*

The serenity of an idyllic village in Southwestern China is shattered when two bandits enter a merchant's shop intent on leaving with his silver. After a flurry of fists, feet and deadly blades, only one man stands to tell the tale, shy peasant Liu Jinxi (Donnie Yen). The investigation by unyielding detective Yu Baijiu (Takeshi Kaneshiro, *Chungking Express*) comes to the attention of The 72 Demons, a clan of ruthless bandits intrigued by the existence of this rejuctant warrior.


In Chinese cinema, drama incorporating martial arts feuds is a classic tradition, like the American western. Wu Xia's star and action director Donnie Yen (Hero, Ip Man) and director Peter Chan (Warlords) reinvent the glory of Hong Kong martial arts cinema from the 60s and 70s, boasting sharp production design and locations that bring to life a town in 1917 rural China that one wishes still existed today. Chan's casting of iconic Shaw Brothers kung fu stars Kara Hui and the legendary Jimmy Wang Yu (The One-Armed Swordsman) as two of the 72 Demons is truly inspired. 
MICKEY GILBERT


Few are as undeniably welcome amongst the company of previous ActionFest Lifetime Achievement award winners Buddy Joe Hooker and Aaron Norris as Mickey Gilbert. One of the industry's most respected stuntmen, Mickey Gilbert has been a man of action his entire life, starting as the youngest

cowboy ever to win the all-around championship of the Los Angeles Coliseum Rodeo (experience that he would later bring to Sam Peckinpah's classic *Junior Bonner*).

Mickey's stunt career began in 1959 when he did uncredited stunt work on the legendary *Ben-Hur*, and 10 years later, he made his reputation by performing one of the greatest stunts in movie history, doubling for Robert Redford (with Howard Curtis for Paul Newman) on the famous cliff jump in the Academy Award-winning *Butch Cassidy and the Sundance Kid*. Numerous classic soon followed, including *The Wild Bunch*, *The Towering Inferno* and *Blazing Saddles*. He then went on to become a respected stunt coordinator and 2nd Unit Director, working in a wide range of genres, from horror (*Night of the Creeps*) to sci-fi (*Freejack*), and such action- based comedies as *City*

Slickers to Mystery Men. Mickey also served both roles in the Asheville-shot classic The Last of the Mohicans in 1992.





Mickey Gilbert is one of those stalwart stuntmen capable of performing practically every kind of stunt, whether it be horse work, car stunts, barroom brawls, because without question, he's one of the original all-round stuntmen. It is truly our honor to award Mickey Gilbert with Lifetime Achievement recognition. The man is handsome enough to double Robert Redford, rugged enough to coordinate stunts on any set, and smart enough to teach us all a thing or two about the movies. Thanks for the memories, Mickey!

Sam Peckinpah's *The Wild Bunch* is one of the most spectacular and violent films ever made. Pike Bishop (William Holden) heads a gang of killers and robbers, including Dutch Engstrom (Ernest Borgnine), Freddie Sykes (Edmond O'Brien), Tector Gorch (Ben Johnson), and Lyle Gorch (Warren Oates). An ex-con and former member of Bishop's gang (Robert Ryan) is hired by a railroad; his task is to kill Bishop within 30 days or go back to prison. Peckinpah's realistic and unrestrained portrayal of violence helped establish the visual language of modern action cinema — the final scene is an epically staged massacre that is still unmatched. — *Rodney Perkins*






This year ActionFest honors career stunt professional Jack Gill

with the Man of Action Award. Gill takes action on and off screen, both as a thrilling stunt professional and as an advocate for the creation of a category at the Oscars for stunt men and women.

Jack Gill got his start in the film business through a chance encounter with a legend. While racing motocross professionally, Gill met Hal Needham, who invited him to visit the set of *Hooper* and then took the up-and-comer under his wing. Because of his racing experience, Jack quickly became known as a car guy and gained steady work doing car stunts on such classic series as *The Dukes of Hazzard*, *The Fall Guy* and *Knight Rider*. Today Jack is primarily a stunt-coordinator and a 2nd Unit Director on such films as *Wild Hogs* and last year's smash hit *Fast Five*.

Amidst all the major hit films that Jack has worked on, he has also become a member of the Screen Actors Guild, the Directors Guild of America, is a former President of Stunts Unlimited, and a member of the Academy of Motion Arts and Sciences. In the past two decades Jack has worked tirelessly as the spokesperson on behalf of the stunt community





J.J. Perry is a fighter. And we don't mean that in the metaphorical, "He'll pull through a tough situation" kind of way. We mean he will fight you. Starting martial arts in 1975, he became such an accomplished young fighter that he was able to enter the US Army under the Elite Athlete Program. During his five years of service, Perry spent time in Korea, where he believes his martial arts skills really leapt to the next level — not to mention his language skills, since he learned to speak Korean!

In 1990, Perry headed to Los Angeles, where he began stunt doubling on TV shows such as *Vanishing Son* and *Renegade*. Eight years into his career as a stuntman Perry joined *Walker, Texas Ranger*, which he credits for his first opportunity to choreograph fights and stunts, and direct second unit.


With his new skill set, Perry graduated to bigger projects, from stunt work on *Mortal Kombat* films to choreographing ActionFest 2010's Best Director Award-winner Isaac Florentine's *Undisputed II: Last Man Standing*. Stunt work on huge hits like *Iron Man* and *Avatar* followed, but 2011 was the year of J.J. Perry's ascension, stunt coordinating the MMA action-drama *Warrior* and the fight choreography for *Haywire*, starring Gina Carano.



The future is only looking up for the man, having already completed *Safe* with Jason Statham, *Get The Gringo* with Mel Gibson and *Bullet To The Head* with Sly Stallone. If those credits don't smack you around enough, he is the fight choreographer on Quentin Tarantino's *Django Unchained!* WHAPP! We're in love with Gina Carano. Honestly, who isn't? She personifies how an intelligent, strong-willed, determined person can, through strength, endurance and hard work, make themselves into one of the world's best athletes and then change course to become one of the strongest new performers to hit the silver screen in some time.

Gina is coming to ActionFest as the recipient of our first-ever Chick Norris-award for Best Female Action Star, based on her breakthrough performance in director Steven Soderbergh's *Haywire*. Soderbergh and screenwriter Lem Dobbs put her through situations that are as hair-raising as in any Bond film, but are totally grounded in reality (no CGI!) and showcase Gina's great fighting skills and stunt work

to excellent effect. But the fact that she more than holds her own against such big screen heavyweights as Michael Fassbender, Ewan McGregor, Michael Douglas and Channing Tatum proves that she's got what it takes as a natural screen presence.

Gina Carano is not just the next big action star; she's a major movie star in the making. It's going to be exciting to see where she goes from here, and we can't wait to see what she does next.



To say that we're excited to have Cung Le here at ActionFest this year is a bit of an understatement. This is someone we've been following very closely over the years, and we're thrilled to bring him to ActionFest to give him our Rising Action Star award and host the North American premiere of his first starring role in *Dragon Eyes*.

It seems like Cung Le was literally born into a world of action. Born in Saigon, Vietnam three days before the city's fall, Cung Le fled the country with his mother on a helicopter under heavy gunfire. Raised in San Jose, California, he started

his training in Taekwondo at the age of 10, which lead to a college wrestling career and his undefeated stint as a professional kick-boxer with a 17-0 record. From here he entered the world of MMA, where he has amassed an impressive 7-2 record over years, starting with Strikeforce and moving on to the UFC.

But now, Le has set his sights on the world of film and we're psyched beyond belief. In a short period of time he's taken on such fighters as John Foo in *Tekken*, Channing Tatum in *Fighting*, and *Wu Xia*'s Donnie Yen in *Bodyguards and Assassins*, along with acting alongside such legends as Chuck Norris on *Walker, Texas Ranger* and his *Dragon Eyes* co-star Jean Claude Van Damme. 2012 will prove to be a pivotal year for Le, with supporting roles in two of the most anticipated films of the year, Wong Kar-

Many reviews out of SXSW have described *The Aggresion Scale* as. *Home Alone* with a psychotic kid as its lead, and that's not far off the mark. Imagine if *3 Ninjas* had an R rating for violence and two less ninjas and that gives you an idea of the surprises in store, but what really works for *The Aggresion Scale* is how it doesn't treat this idea as a joke. It's a straight-up action film with a couple of kick-ass kids, terrorized by a team of killers out to find \$500,000 in stolen cash that one of their parents might have stolen from a gangster, as the heroes—got a problem with that? Better not. There's also a pretty cool cast of villains, led by Dana Ashbrook and Ray Wise (reunited from *Twin Peaks*) and featuring *Friday The 13th*'s most recent Jason, Derek Mears, plus some of most nasty and creative kills in recent movie memory. And while it's not a movie for kids by any means, it does prove that young people can make exciting action heroes. Tough, brutal but also wicked fun, *The Aggresion Scale* rates high for action. — *Matthew Kiernan*

Fans of action cinema know that there is one man who stands for all that's right in the movies that we cherish so much and we love him because he is such a "bad ass." Now he steps up to prove it in the world premiere of this self-titled action thriller and that man is...Danny Treio.

Hot off the success of *Machete* (which we at ActionFest 2011 dubbed "Action Film of the Year"), he switches from cutting out someone's intestine and using it as a rope to descend down the face of a building to... cargo shorts and a fanny pack? In *Bad Ass*, we find our Trejo with a graying beard as Vietnam vet Frank Vega who, after being shunned by society for nearly 40 years, becomes an instant celebrity when he smacks around some skinheads on a city bus and footage of the incident goes viral, earning him the nickname "Bad Ass." When his best friend is murdered—and police seem unwilling to help—Vega takes his new nickname to the extreme against corrupt cops and a crooked mayor (Ron Perlman) and his enforcer (Charles S. Dutton). Played with a wink inbetween smackdowns, Trejo channels some of Michael Caine from *Harry Brown* and Charles Bronson from *Death Wish* and dishes out old-school cinema justice. — *Colin Geddes*





A GANG STORY

Based on former gangster Edmond Vidal's autobiography, A Gang Story looks back at one of France's most notorious crime syndicates, Le Gang des Lyonnais. The leader of the gang, a proud and dignified man from another era, Vidal (Gérard Lanvin from Mesrine, Point Blank) is now in his sixties but still believes in values and honor. Retired from "the business" and wishing to lead a peaceful life, Vidal is asked to help break his old friend and partner Serge (Tchéky Karyo from Kiss of the Dragon, La Femme Nikita) out of prison.

A Gang Story takes on an increasingly tragic air, as we watch characters embark on actions they know will probably lead to their own destruction. Just as *The Godfather* both drew on and diverged from earlier gangster films, so too director Olivier Marchal, himself a former police officer, evokes American examples of the genre to highlight their differences with French criminal life. Marchal has made a solid return to gangster films in the vein of *The Town* and *Heat*, but in the French style, of course. (In French with English subtitles)

With *God Bless America*, Bobcat is everything but subtle. Character actor Joel Murray puts a comedic twist on the angry Everyman and Tara Lynn Barr is full of a spitfire charm as she delivers sermons on just who deserves to get the barrel end of their justice. Get ready to hit the road with the Bonnie & Clyde of the 21st Century. — *Colin Geddes*

"Meet Doug, The Nicest Guy You'll Ever Fight." An outcast from his brainy family, bouncer Doug Glatt (Seann William Scott) finds fame when he joins a local hockey team and beats down his opponents, much to the delight of fans: In his new role as enforcer (whose role is to protect teammates and act as a deterrent by hitting or fighting opposing players who take liberties with teammates), Doug "The Thug" leads a team of under performing misfits to semi-pro hockey glory, beating the crap out of everything that stands in his way, until he meets his idol, veteran enforcer Ross "The Boss" Rhea (Liev Schreiber).

One of the most unexpected action comedies in recent years, *Goon* is able to spin a strong emotional core about a hopeless outcast who can only get by in the world with his fists thanks to a rather surprising performance by Scott. Inspired by a book based on real-life infamous NHL ice brawls and written by actor-writer Jay Baruchel (who plays Doug's foul-mouthed bleacher cussing pal Pat) and directed Michael Dowse, (the man who gave the world the mullet cult classic *Fubar*) *Goon* perfectly manages to balance the icy fisticuffs and guffaws.

This twisted tale of a corporate headhunter who moonlights as a professional art thief provides enough action, suspense, surprises and all-out fun to remind us there's a reason these Scandinavian authors are so popular: they really know how to tell a story and entertain an audience, something *Headhunters* does with exceptional skill. Every day after school, two groups of thirteen-year old friends play "war" in a local forest. They make their own guns out of sticks or old toys, anything they can find. But in their minds these makeshift weapons are the real thing, AK-47s, Grenade launchers, Even a pair of eyes that shoot lasers. It's all fun and games, until one afternoon when things gets a little out of hand as bullies, pre-teen crushes, and popularity contests all come into play on the battlefield. No Disney G-rated family fun here as as our heroes speak like real kids and brandish heavy artillery. Their friendships, loyalties and the tactics of their "game" are tested to the ultimate degree and, like their adult counterparts in the "real" world, find that victory and defeat are celebrated and suffered in equal proportion. With cinematic groundings in Stand By Me meets Full Metal Jacket and overtones of Lord of the Flies. I Declare War is certainly a film that is bound to spark topical conversation.

LET THE BULLETS FLY

First things first: this movie is a hell of a lot of fun. Second thing: while unquestionably loaded with action, Let The Bullets Fly is also a comedy, and a densely packed one, at that. Paying close attention is very much advised, because if you miss one little detail, you might lose place. But don't let that scare you off, because Let The Bullets Fly is easily one of the most entertaining movies to come out of China in a long time. It overtook Avatar as the highest-grossing film in that country's history, showing that Chinese filmmakers can provide big entertainment that outdoes Hollywood.

Jiang Wen stars as Pocky Zhang, a notorious bandit whose latest robbery has him stealing the role of Governor of a small province from conman Ge You. But his dream of taking the money and running becomes harder than he thinks, thanks to a ruthless crime lord played by the legendary Chow Yun Fat. The stage is then set for a battle of wits between three criminals, fighting for control of a small town that could be worth millions. We don't want to reveal any more for fear of spoiling it, so we'll just say that yes, the bullets do fly in Let The Bullets Fly, but so do the laughs. - Matthew Kiernan

THE LOST BLADESMAN

Donnie Yen has been kicking ass in movies for nearly 30 years, yet as he approaches 50 he's just hitting his stride. Star of some of the best action films of the last decade (including ActionFest 2010 selection 14 Blades and this year's closing night film, Wu Xia) he's got another winner on his hands with The Lost Bladesman, a grandiose epic that recalls the great Shaw Brothers swordplay films of the 70s.

Adapted from the classic Chinese tale Romance of the Three Kingdoms, the film sees Yen as legendary Guan Yu, whose journey of the five passes (and the slaying of six generals) played a pivotal role in the collapse of the Han dynasty. As directed by Alan Mak and Felix Chong (whose Infernal Affairs was remade in the US as The Departed), The Lost Bladesman does a beautiful job of telling its story of honor, loyalty and revenge with visual flair and jaw-dropping action. It also provides a fine showcase for Donnie Yen, the actor, proving once and again that he's a strong presence beyond action. One of the unquestionable highlights of ActionFest 2012. The armies of hell have taken over the Earth, and all that stands in the way of the villainous Count Draculon and his total subjugation of humanity is a motley lot of misfits seemingly torn from the pantheon of 80s schlock genre-cinema. There's an Australian punk, a knife-wielding anime chick, a kung-fu master (voiced with deliriously pitch-perfect stoicism by Kyle Herbert, the narrator from *Dragon Ball Z*), and of course the titular Manborg, a literal kind of cinematic Frankenstein, both emblematic of pulp sci-fi as obscure as Charles Band's *Eliminators* and as broad as *Robocop* and *The Terminator*.

The master of ceremonies to this cacophony of laser blasts and comic book ultra-violence is film collective Astron-6 (*Father's Day*) special effects prodigy Steven Kostanski, who deftly juggles co-writing, editing and directing duties with the ambitious creation of an extraordinary barrage of elaborate miniatures, iconic costumes and delirious stopmotion creatures that would have Harryhausen and Tippet try to high-five the ghost of David W. Allen out of sheer enthusiasm. Kostanski's universe remains unmistakably original, his voice unquestionably unique and his talent impossible to deny. — *Peter Kuplowsky*

ActionFest fans first became aware of star Iko Uwais and director Gareth Evans when *Merantau* won Best Picture in 2010, but until then, Western film fans had never even heard about the traditional Indonesian combat style of Silat, let alone seen a martial arts flick from that part of the world. Now the dynamic duo of Evans and Uwais are back with *The Raid*.

Deep in Jakarta's slums lies an impenetrable gangster safe house, considered untouchable to even the bravest of police. Cloaked under the cover of pre-dawn darkness, an elite swat team is tasked with a raid to take down a notorious drug lord. But when the building's lights are cut and all the exits blocked, the unit must fight their way out through the city's worst. So sayeth Method Man in director William Kaufman's *Sinners and Saints*, a down-and-dirty action flick that nods to classics from *Lethal Weapon* and *Heat*. Detective Sean Riley (Mark Strong of *Black Hawk Down* and *The Fast and the Furious*) is a stone cold detective in the post-Katrina (and borderline post-apocalyptic) city. When charred corpses turn up across the underbelly of the city, Riley teams up with a new partner to crack the case. But very quickly the case gets red hot, with the city's biggest drug dealer and a team of elite mercenaries going head-to-head against Riley and his men.

Inducting Strong into heavy-hitting leading man status and with a cast featuring Tom Berenger, Jurgen Prochnow, Method Man and Sean Patrick Flannery, there is plenty of recognizable talent to either kill or be killed. Kaufman (director of the breakout indie hits *The Prodigy* and *The Hit List*) builds a brutal world filled with tightly choreographed and realistically staged action on an independent budget, from elaborate shoot-outs to brutal hand-to-hand combat. — Ed Travis







